

- Register of Deeds Association was established in 1928
- Title changed to County Recorder in 2001
- Elected and Appointed
 - Elected for 4 year terms



- 1997 Red River Valley Flood
- \$1.2 million FEMA grant
- Solely for Disaster Proofing
- 50 Counties Export
- Two back-up sites
- Approximately 2,000 monthly subscribers – ability to search 24/7
