Visited every household in a development when he noticed an infestation of poisonous Spotted Hemlock to warn them of the danger and inform them how to control the weeds.



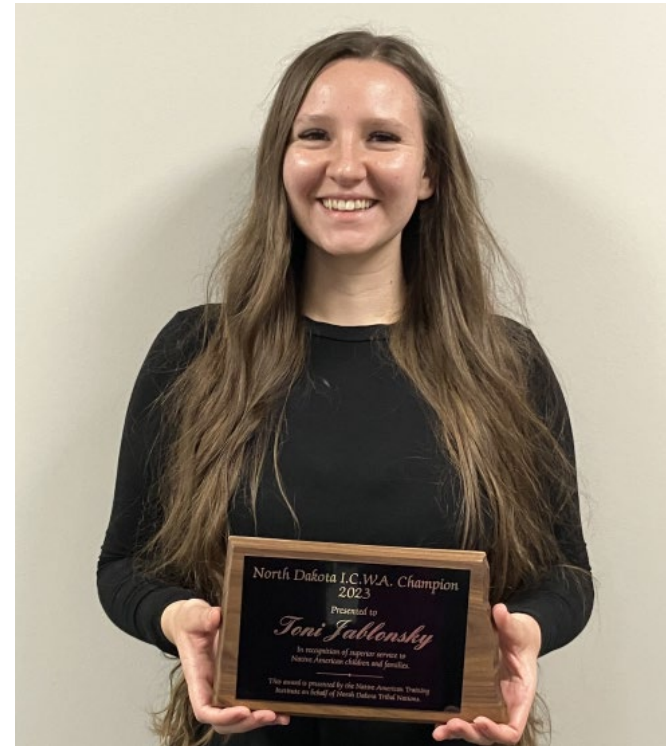

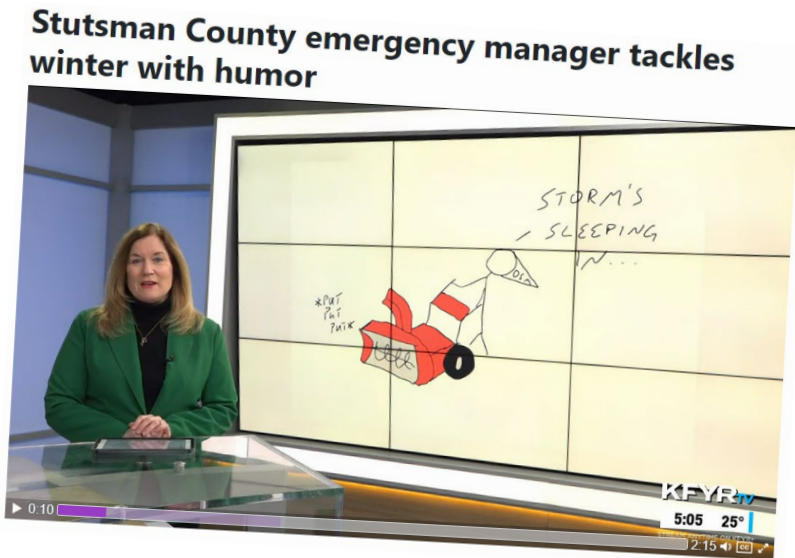
