- This form, fully completed, signed and dated by student applicant.
- A resume or listing of work experience, volunteerism, awards/recognition, etc.

- Personal statement about your academic goals and expectations. (limit 300 words)
- Essay that answers the question, "How has your parent's/grandparent's experience in county government helped shape who you are?" (limit 300 words)
- An official transcript from the high school or college most recently attended.
